Organization of studies: Which classes in which semester?

The last column in the following tables names the exam type, corresponding to formal requirements of the study program. “Z” stands for Polish “zaliczenie” and means the successful completion of the class. “E” stands for Polish “egzamin”. In subjects of that type, you are graded twice: you get one grade for fulfilling the requirements for successful completion of the class and one grade for some extra assessment. Note that in both types the actual form of assessment may be a written test, an oral exam, a project, or several smaller tasks. Teachers are required to specify the form of assessment no later than in the second week of the semester.

Be aware that most subjects require a considerable amount of individual work outside of classes such as reading and carrying out individual or group projects. This work has to be done continually during the semester, not at exam time. We recommend a workload of 30 ECTS per semester.

Comments

¹⁾ You need three classes of the module “**Methods and Applications**” in total. You may choose between one in your first year and two in your second year, or two in your first and one in your second year. These classes are offered only in the winter semester. The topics vary. In 2022/2023 the topics are: (i) Sociolinguistics, (ii) Gesture analysis, and (iii) Lexicography.

²⁾ You can choose your “**Foreign language**” (not English!) from the offer of the Institute of Applied Linguistics and other institutes of the Faculty of Modern Languages and Literatures. International students can also choose Polish classes offered by the School of Polish Language and Culture. You have to organize this by yourself, but we strongly recommend **consulting your choice with your tutor Dr. Dorota Owczarek or ELLDO coordinator Prof. Nicole Nau**. They will help you! In some cases you need to follow a certain procedure in order to get the language class into your record in USOS. You have to take care that the total amount of teaching hours during the two years will be no smaller than 240 and the total amount of ECTS credits is 24. That is, on average your classes should have 60 hours (= two classes of 90 minutes per week) and 6 ECTS per semester. One class, preferably the last, has to have the exam type “E”. You may also change your language during the two years, or take classes in an additional language to fill up the teaching hours and credits.

All non-Polish students at our university are encouraged to take lessons in Polish.

³⁾ In the course of the two years, you have to complete 5 “**Additional lectures**”. One of these must have the exam type “E”. Be aware that not for all lectures this exam type is offered, so consult this question at the beginning of the semester with the teacher. You can choose Additional lectures from the offer at the Institute of Applied Linguistics, other institutes of the Faculty of Modern Languages and Literatures (if the teacher accepts you), and the offer of AMU-PIE (<https://amupie.e-msi.pl/>). You are encouraged to choose one or two classes from disciplines other than linguistics, for example, social sciences, educational science, or Polish culture. You may consult your options with any of the ELLDo teachers. The language of the class may be English, Polish, or another language.

⁴⁾ The exam of the MA seminar is the final exam after your thesis has been accepted and graded.
